# East Campus NEWs

The Holidays were a busy time with lots of food and gifts for families. 40 families received gifts as a joint effort of the Dayton Christian Center East and the Epiphany Lutheran Church just before Thanksgiving. Many families were adopted for Christmas and 40 families were provided toys for children in their homes and food for the families.

On the programming track, the East site has shifted to specific programming serving the Adult Parole Authority, Probation, the YWCA, and many more organization in Montgomery County. Programming then allows case management services as clients go thru the program. We have been serving numerous clients with employment services such as resume and employment readiness services.

We continue the teen pregnancy prevention classes two days a week and use the computer lab five days a week at the East site. Our youth utilize the ECOT computers Monday thru Friday between 10am and 2pm to work on their high school education. This ECOT school year has gotten off to a good start and the youth have passed all their tests to date.

Conflict resolution classes continue to be a critical piece of our site for the youth. The classes help the youth learn to appropriately respond to situations as opposed to the previous negative reaction they had before. Youth to date even come to staff and request more classes when they feel that they need them and tensions are rising. This is exactly what we teach the youth to do and lets us know that the classes are working.

GED class and study is available Monday thru Friday. To date we have had seven clients for GED study at the East site. Please feel free to contact us or come and visit to see and use the computers and study area. Each student receives a study packet to start the process. To date we have had 10 students and are looking forward to many more as we move forward and in the beginning stages.
